The Paystation Online Payment Service

Overview

Paystation offers a way to pass transactions to bank and card scheme payment servers in a way that has minimal impact on a merchants systems. Paystation takes a payment request from a merchants systems and repackages it into a Digital Order using the QSI Payment Client software and initiates either a 3-party or 2-party transaction. When a transaction is completed Paystation decrypts the Digital Receipt and passes the result back to the merchants systems.

Features

- 2-party or 3-party transactions
- simple interface – no software to install on the merchants server
- cross-platform (Windows, MacOS, Unix, Linux, etc) and cross-language (ASP, PHP, PERL, Python, etc)
- looks up lost transactions and notifies the merchant of the findings
- pre-authorisations and authorisations (QSI captures) if the financial institutions systems can handle them
- multiple carts and systems can co-exist over a single Paystation account
- multiple Paystation accounts can co-exist over a single Merchant Account.

Cost

One-off setup fee: \$200.00

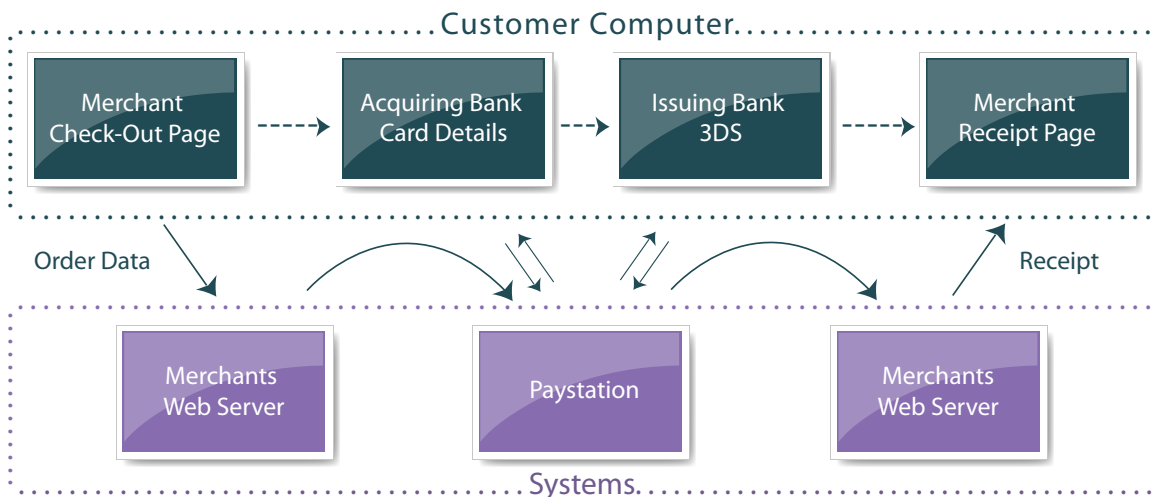
Per transaction charge: \$0.10

Minimum monthly fee: \$15.00

All costs are exclusive of GST. Volume discounts apply.

How it works

The Merchant's system sends a simple encrypted request over the Internet to our server, containing a code to identify the merchant, a code to uniquely identify the payment, and the amount of the payment. The result of the transaction sent to the Merchants system contains the unique code to identify the payment, a result code, and a result message.



Merchants can pass additional data with the transaction, which is returned with the result. This can be useful for 'remembering' session state within the merchants system.
